PPCC'S RN-BSN PROGRAM GETS FULL ACCREDITATION

Pikes Peak Community College's RN-BSN program has cleared its final accreditation hurdle.

The Board of Commissioners of the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE) has notified PPCC that, after extensive research and a virtual site visit, the college's Registered Nurse to Bachelor of Science in Nursing Program is now fully accredited.

PPCC graduated its first cohort from the program in May.

The accreditation is retroactive to the date of the site visit, which occurred in February of 2021, so all of our graduates, past and future will graduate from a fully accredited RN-BSN program.
