



PPCC Child Development Center Rates Fall Semester 2021 – Summer Semester 2022

PPCC CDC Full rates are follows:

Infant Program	\$72 per full day	\$36 Friday rate
Toddler Program	\$70 per full day	\$35 Friday rate
Preschool Program	\$66 per full day	\$33 Friday rate

Registration fee is \$45 per child per semester.

- **Students are prioritized for enrollment at the Child Development Center.**
- **Students must be enrolled in at least 6 credit hours for the semester.**
- **Children must be enrolled for a minimum of two days per week.**

- **If you are a student at Pikes Peak Community College:**
 The Child Development Center is able to provide sliding scale rates and accept CCCAP from Department of Human Services because student funds supplement the difference in cost.
 - In order to receive sliding scale rates or for the Child Development Center to accept DHS assistance, we require a parent to be enrolled in and maintain at least six credits per semester at PPCC
 - Sliding scale rates are based on your current FAFSA
 - Additional childcare funding assistance may be available
